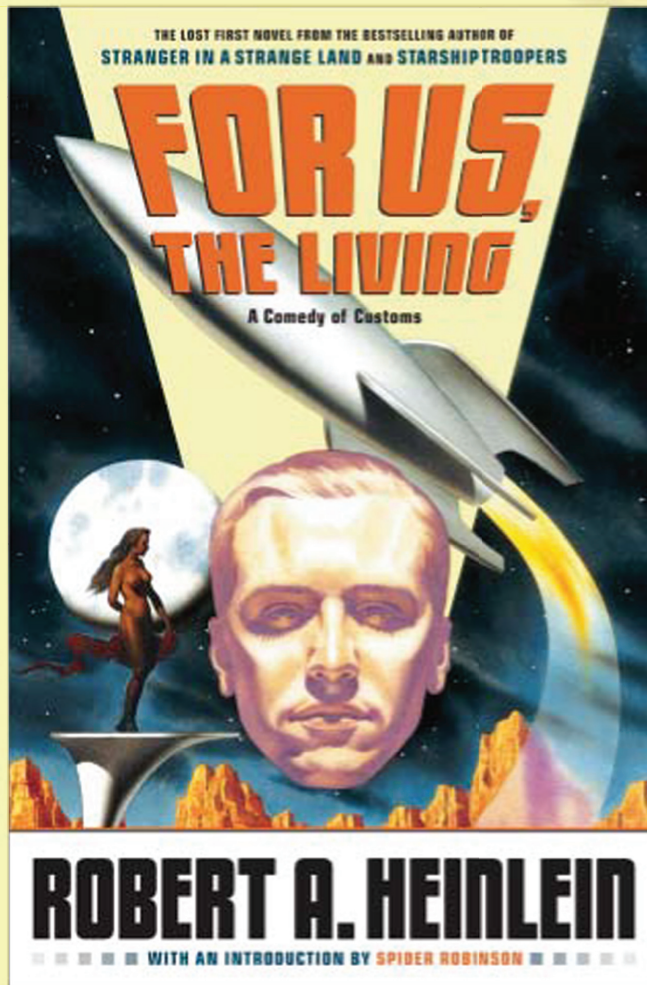
Brad Linaweaver, J. Neil
