48 **Minutes:** Minutes for April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2015 were approved on a unanimous vote.

51 **Treasurer's Report:** Total Cash Balance as of June 1st:

52 \$16,208.46, of which \$7,359.11 is reserved for the Hall of Famous

53 Missourians bust. This balance reflects the contribution from Jeb

54 Kinnison of \$4,500 (minus Paypal fees) received on 6/1. This is a

55 change of \$6,214.88 from the previous month, and a change of

56 \$7,119.65 from the same month in the previous year.

57 Also see attached "Profit and Loss YTD" for September 2014-May

58 2015 (the Society's current Fiscal Year).

59 He also reported on the Balticon convention and the ceremony

60 presenting THS' increased annual contribution (\$1,000 total) as of

61 the 2016 Heinlein Award.

63 Vice President-Secretary's Report: VP Rule reported working,

64 per the Board's direction, to make recordings of recent board

65 meetings available to members of the board, and chairs, on a

66 secure page at the Society's website, and making the authentication

67 details available to board and chairs. He also wrote several pieces

68 for the Society website about progress on the Hall of Famous

69 Missourians Bust project, and soliciting suggested wordings for the 70 plaque which will accompany the Bust. He additionally submitted

71 a suggested plaque wording contribution of his own.

President's Report: The President reported that he's received the
 new batch of convention ribbons previously ordered from Ribbons
 Galore.

78 He noted with Jeb Kinnison's donation, and assuming Heinlein

79 Prize Trust honors their matching commitment as expected, the

80 Society has reached its fundraising goal for the Hall of Famous

81 Missourians Bust with a total of \$14,545.86 expected to be

82 available to use for all facets of the project. Further contributions

83 are now closed. He also reviewed the expected next steps and

potential timelines for completion of the bust with the sculptor.

The president informed the board the sculptor would require an

initial payment of \$5,000.00 to actively start the project.
