

Savings: \$20,163.99 "Lifetime Reserved" Account

Unreserved Capital Balance: \$20,435.89

2016 Capital Balance: \$20,596.95

2015 Capital Balance: \$7,571.74

The Board adopted a spending policy for Lifetime Memberships:

- We have limited spending to \$50 per Life Member per year for 15 years once the Membership is paid
- For example we will be allowing \$1,450 of the Savings listed above to be moved in FY 18 to be spent

Our "Operations Expense" ratio reads on the prior chart as 6.91%

Our "Operations to Programs" ratio is 10.25%, slightly better than last year



- Rob Sawyer 2017 Heinlein Award winner. THS represented at ceremony by Board Member Beatrice Kondo.






Ensign's Prize Program

- Initially opened to THS Members only
 - Will be opened to general public 15 Sep 2017
- Income to date \$3,545.00



Heinlein For Heroes

- Herb Gilliland, Chair
- FY 2016-17: H4H shipped 3,058 books in 297 shipments
 - > Total since beginning: about 14,650 books
- \$6,600.90 total expenses
- Future: Expect to send ~ 3,000 books per year w/ THS providing books and HPT paying for shipping
 - > Trust reimbursed \$2,027.35 for FY 2016-17 shipping expenses
 - Books mostly cash purchases; some books donated at conventions like Balticon, plus individual donations
