Our "Operations to Programs" ratio is 10.38%.

We have another 8.7% for just rent and bank fee expenses that we look every year to reduce.

Fully 60.5% of our outlay every year relates to our "big three" programs—Scholarships, H4H, and Blood Drive support.

By most non-profit measurements we remain a very efficient organization. We have several key members that donate operating expenses each year which don't show up on charts because of accounting rules.

## **Ensign's Prize Program**



- FY 2017-18: H4H shipped 3,533 books
  - > Total since beginning: about 19,102 books
- \$7,266.66 total expenses
  - > Trust to reimburse for shipping expenses
- Future: Expect to send ~ 3,000 books per year w/ THS providing books and HPT paying for shipping
- Books mostly cash purchases; donations of cash and books by YOU.






