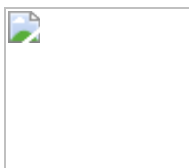


January 2014 Heinlein Society News and Updates:

Tentative schedule is 2p-7p on Friday with them, and perhaps a greater spread in the hours for the MGH buses on Saturday, 9a-5p

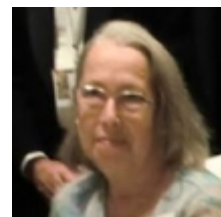
Heinlein For Heroes Passes 1000 Books Sent!
